School Swimming Scheme

Dear parents/carers,

The School Swimming Scheme will be running next term and it is a wonderful opportunity for students to develop their skills and confidence in the water. We only have space for 30 students and places will be offered on a first note and payment in, first served basis. The places have been offered to Year 2 students first, and are now open to students in Years 3 – 6.

Date: Monday 16/10/17 – Friday 27/10/17

Time: Leave school at 12:30pm and return by 2:30pm

Location: Western Suburbs Pool (Unanderra)

Transport: Transport will be by bus

Cost: \$40 (\$4 for the bus each day).
There is no charge for entry to the pool or for the swimming lessons.
The \$40 must be paid upfront before the School Swimming Scheme starts.

Uniform: Students should wear full school uniform and bring their swimming costume with them in their school bag. Time will be allocated for students to change into swimming costumes at school and they will change back into their uniforms upon arrival at school.

SCHOOL SWIMMING AND WATER SAFETY PROGRAM

Message to Parents / Caregivers

Arrangements have been made to include a learn to swim program in our school curriculum.

The Department of Education School Swimming and Water Safety Program is an intensive learn to swim program, which develops water confidence and provides students with basic skills in water safety and survival. The Program is conducted over ten days. Each daily lesson is 45 minutes.

Students who have not reached a satisfactory standard of water safety and survival skills, and are unable to swim 25m confidently unaided in deep water, are eligible to participate in the School Swimming Program. The Program focuses on weak swimmers in Year 2 to 6 as well as students with special needs such as new arrivals in Australia and students with disabilities. If there are places available more able swimmers will be able to participate also.

Instruction will take place at Western Suburbs pool. (Unanderra)

The Program will continue daily for two weeks from 16/10/17 to 27/10/17. There will be no charge for instruction.

Transport will cost \$ 4.00 per day. Pool entry will cost \$ 0 per day.

The total cost for the 10 day program is \$ 40.

Each child should bring a swimming costume, a towel, shirt, hat and warm clothing on a cool day. Where instruction takes place in an outdoor pool, it is recommended that students use adequate sun protection, eg. an SPF 50+ broad spectrum, water-resistant sun screen reapplied regularly. A T-shirt or rash shirt is also recommended (pool facility permitting).

Students will be assessed during the School Swimming Program for all water safety skills without wearing goggles.
